Since the program was launched in fall 1989 as a collaborative partnership of schools, businesses and the Worthington Area Chamber of Commerce, it has groomed for our community more than 200 new leaders who are graduates of an intense nine-month program of personal and leadership skills development. Now active members of civic and human service organizations, the graduates left lasting legacies through class projects completed as part of the program. Their efforts are remembered when volunteers pool resources each spring on Service Day to assist senior citizens and clean up public areas ... or computer users view Worthington's community Web site ... or visitors at our Municipal Building read the names of exemplary citizens who have been honored with Leadership for a Lifetime Awards.

Worthington's youth also are prepared for responsible positions of leadership in our community, thanks to Leadership Tomorrow, a youth-focused partner program of Leadership Worthington which debuted in 1997. To date, five classes of students from area public and private schools have developed their communication, time management and volunteer skills through the program.

In fostering new leadership, recognizing and rewarding existing leaders, and serving as a catalyst for positive change in our community, Leadership Worthington is advancing its mission to better the quality of life in our community.
